Dear Mr. Widstrand:

We have completed our review of a project of the City of Madison Parks Division to place an intake structure on the bed of Odana Pond in the Township of Madison. The project will result in the discharge of dredged material in conjunction with excavating a 30 linear-foot trench for the intake pipeline across wetlands adjacent to the pond, including the discharge of riprap material in an area of 400 square feet in the pond at the end of the intake pipeline. This project site is in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 31, T. 7N., R. 9E., Dane County, Wisconsin.

This work is authorized by Department of the Army General Permit (GP/LOP-98-WI) **PROVIDED THE ENCLOSED CONDITIONS ARE FOLLOWED AND YOU OBTAIN CONFIRMATION THAT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION HAS BEEN GRANTED OR WAIVED FOR THE PROJECT** from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR). Your project **IS NOT** authorized by this **general permit** until you obtain this confirmation of water quality certification from WDNR.

You should contact **Cami Peterson** of the WDNR office in Milwaukee, WI (phone: (608) 275-3208), concerning water quality certification for your project.

If your project will require off-site fill material that is **not** obtained from a licensed commercial facility, you must notify us at least five working days before start of work. A cultural resources survey may be required if a licensed commercial facility is not used.

The time limit for completing this authorized work ends two years from the date of this letter.

It is your responsibility to ensure that the work complies with the terms of this letter and the enclosures **AND TO OBTAIN ALL REQUIRED STATE AND LOCAL PERMITS AND APPROVALS BEFORE YOU PROCEED WITH YOUR PROJECT.**

If you disagree with the enclosed jurisdictional determination, you may provide new information. Please follow the directions in Section D of the enclosed Notification of Administrative Appeal Options and Process and Request for Appeal.
