
Summer Curtailable Service Rider

AVAILABILITY

Available to customers on Rate Schedules Cg-1, Cg-2, Cg-4, Cg-6, and Sp-3 who contract for service for a period of one year with a minimum on-peak curtailable load of 75 kW measured over a 15-minute time period. This service is designed for customers who have the ability to control all or a portion of their loads for limited periods during extreme peak conditions.

RATE

All the provisions of the applicable Cg-1, Cg-2, Cg-4, Cg-6, and Sp-3 rate schedules will apply with the exception that a customer served on this rider will have the on-peak demand charge for that portion of the customer's load designated as curtailable reduced during the summer season as follows:

1. Demand Charge Credit = Percent of available on-peak hours x spot price (\$ per kW per day).
2. That portion of the customer's load designated as interruptible is defined as the difference between the customer's maximum on-peak, 15-minute demand and the contract firm demand level.
3. The percent of available on-peak hours is defined as the number of on-peak hours the customer's load may be curtailed during the summer season, as specified in the customer's contract with the Company, divided by the total summer season on-peak hours.
4. The spot price is defined as the estimated short-term market value of firm capacity (\$ per kW per day) for the summer season. The spot price will be updated, subject to approval of the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin, no later than January 31 of each calendar year. For the 2004 summer season, the spot price is \$0.19726 per kW per day.

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

If the measured maximum on-peak, 15-minute demand is greater than the contract firm demand level, the load designated as curtailable will be equal to the difference between the measured maximum on-peak, 15-minute demand and the contract firm demand level. If the measured maximum on-peak, 15-minute demand is less than the contract firm demand level, the load designated as curtailable is zero.

CONDITIONS OF DELIVERY

1. A customer receiving service under this rider must enter into a contract that specifies a contract firm demand level.
2. After receiving notification by the Company, the customer must curtail load to no more than the contract firm demand level and remain at or below the contract firm demand level until notified by the Company that the curtailment period has ended and service has been resumed. **Failure to comply with this provision will result in an unauthorized use of electricity.**
3. The customer will be notified by the Company when curtailment is to occur. The Company will have sole discretion on the length of interruption and the amount of time between notification and actual curtailment, subject to the terms of the contract between the customer and the Company.
4. The availability of service under this rate may be limited at the discretion of the Company. Service under this rate may be refused if the Company believes the load to be curtailed will not provide adequate load reduction when the Company desires curtailment.
5. The customer will, at customer's expense, install all apparatus and materials necessary for the proper utilization of power furnished by the Company including disconnect mains and monitoring equipment. All such apparatus will conform to the Company's rules and regulations and will be kept in suitable operating condition at all times.



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6. Service under this rate will be subject to curtailment at the sole discretion of the Company. Curtailments will be limited to the summer season pricing period. There will be no more than 150 hours of curtailment in a calendar year, and the frequency will not exceed 36 per year. Interruptions due to lightning, wind, or other causes other than intentional curtailment by the Company will not be considered in determining the hours or frequency of curtailment.
7. The customer will pay the full demand charge (no credit will be applied) for the first instance of unauthorized use of electricity during a contract year. The customer will pay \$25 per kilowatt for each additional instance during the same contract year of unauthorized use of electricity during a period of curtailment called by the Company. The Company may suspend service under this rate if the customer uses service during periods of curtailment and thereafter serve the customer under the appropriate rate.
8. The customer will pay, in advance of construction, all costs estimated by the Company for facilities to serve the curtailable load.
9. The Company will not be liable for any damages sustained by the customer because of interruptions, deficiencies, or imperfections of electric service provided under this rate.
10. Curtailable service will not be used as standby for any other forms of energy or fuel.
11. Service under this rate will be furnished only in accordance with the Electric Service Rules and Regulations of the Company.
12. Energy furnished under this rate will not be resold.
