Effective Jan. 1, 2026, electric and natural gas rates changed.

In 2025, MGE worked collaboratively with community and customer representatives in our regulatory process to reach a unanimous rate settlement agreement that resolved all issues in our rate case. The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) reviewed and approved this agreement, which established our electric and natural gas rates.

Electric

- A typical MGE residential electric customer using 500 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month will see an increase of about \$0.13 per month.
- Impacts for non-residential electric customers vary by rate class.
- The primary drivers of the change are investments in local generation resources and ongoing grid modernization projects that help ensure reliable electric service for our community.

Natural Gas

- A typical MGE residential natural gas customer using 720 therms per year will see a monthly bill increase of about \$1.91.
- Impacts for non-residential natural gas customers vary by rate class.
- The primary driver of the change is continued investment in system modernization projects that support a safe, dependable natural gas system serving our community.

Your natural gas bill includes:

- **Firm Gas Sales Service**—the costs associated with the purchase of firm natural gas supply to ensure uninterrupted deliveries by MGE's interstate pipelines.
- **Residential Distribution Service**—the costs associated with maintaining MGE's natural gas distribution system to help ensure safe and reliable natural gas is delivered to your home.
