



To Our Customers:

MGE has submitted an application to the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) for approval of its 2027 fuel cost plan as required by State law. As proposed, the fuel cost plan would add a small surcharge to approved 2027 electric rates.

In 2025, the PSCW approved a 3.6% increase in electric rates for 2027. With the proposed surcharge, that would mean a total increase of 3.64% in 2027. An MGE residential electric customer with typical usage of 500 kilowatt-hours (kWh) a month would expect to see a bill increase of about \$5.31 a month; the proposed surcharge would add \$0.03 per month to the monthly bill. Impacts for non-residential customers vary by rate class.

MGE works to keep costs down. Including this proposed update, the average annual increase in MGE electric rates from 2018 through 2027 would be 1.7%.

The PSCW will provide opportunities for public comment and will schedule a hearing on the proposed 2027 fuel cost plan at a later date.
