

Stay warm this winter!



Households having difficulty paying heating and electricity costs this season may qualify for energy assistance. The help is administered by the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program.

Assistance is available for a range of household costs:

- One-time payment to partially cover heating costs
- One-time payment to pay a portion of the household's electrical (non-heating) costs
- Emergency assistance for households without heat due to a variety of reasons, including a nonoperating furnace or boiler

Apply now—funds are limited and may run out quickly.

Assistance guidelines for the 2025-2026 season (10/01/2025 through 09/30/2026)

You may be eligible if your gross income is less than the amount shown for your family size.
