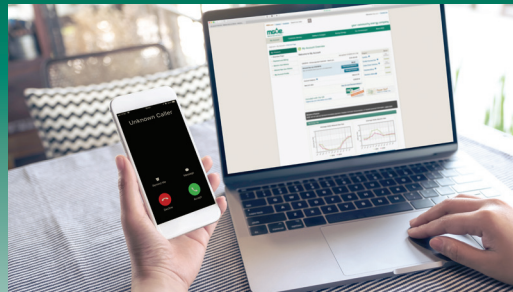

Utility scams are occurring nationwide, targeting both residences and businesses. Scammers may call or visit and request that you pay a past-due bill with a prepaid debit card or with a wire transfer. They often threaten immediate disconnection if you don't comply. This is not MGE.

Beware of utility scams. MGE does not:

- ask for money to replace or work on your meter.
- charge for line-clearance work.
- charge for tree trimming.
- collect a bill payment at your home or business.
- shut off your power without providing notification in writing.

Please do not provide your social security number, credit card numbers or bank account information to anyone during an unsolicited call.
