Basic Utility Services

Effective January 1, 2022

We take seriously our responsibility to provide safe, reliable energy at reasonable rates. We work hard to control our costs.

In 2021, MGE worked with intervening parties to file a rate settlement agreement to resolve all issues in MGE's rate case. The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) reviewed and approved the settlement agreement, setting our electric and gas rates.

Residential electric and natural gas rates will increase in 2022.

- The typical MGE residential electric customer using 500 kilowatt-hours per month will see an increase of about \$6.54 a month.
- The typical MGE residential gas customer using 720 therms per year will see an increase of about \$1.02 per month if broken down monthly.

Electric costs for 2022 include construction costs associated with the Badger Hollow Solar Farm, which came online in late 2021; the end of a one-time deferred tax credit to customers as a result of the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act; and technology improvements including a new customer information system. Costs were updated from the initial application to address increased fuel prices.

The primary reason for the gas increase is technology improvements and infrastructure costs to maintain a safe and dependable system.

Your monthly payment amount will stay the same for a minimum of six months. After six months, we will review your usage on a monthly basis. If your energy usage has changed, we will provide you with a new budget amount for a six-month time period.

Residential-Controlled Water Heating (Rw-1)

An option if you have an electric water heater. In exchange for lower rates, your water heater is placed on a separate meter and a special timer to control when it operates. The charge for an electrician to install the meter and timer can cost you several hundred dollars.

Natural Gas Services

Your natural gas bill includes:

- Firm Gas Sales Service—the costs to buy and supply natural gas
- Residential Distribution Service—the costs to maintain our gas system and deliver gas to your home

Firm Gas Sales Service (FS-1)

Administrative charge \$0.0144 per therm

Natural gas service*

- Summer (Apr. 1 - Oct. 31) \$0.4063 per therm
- Winter (Nov. 1 - Mar. 31) \$0.4566 per therm

Residential Distribution Service (RD-1)

System connection and customer service charge \$0.7195 per day

Distribution service \$0.1973 per therm

* Subject to adjustment for the cost of purchased gas.

System connection and customer service charge: Every customer receives this charge whether or not natural gas is used.
