Households having difficulty paying heating and electricity costs this season may qualify for energy assistance. The help is administered by the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP).

Assistance is available for a range of household costs:

- One-time payment to partially cover heating costs
- One-time payment to pay a portion of the household's electrical (non-heating) costs
- Emergency assistance for households without heat due to a variety of reasons including a nonoperating furnace or boiler
